efforts in all directions and do hope that I could live up to all your expectations.



to all members of our fraternity who have fought the virus, so that others could live.






### Professor GMS Choudhary - A tribute

Man is mortal, but that dictum hardly consoles a mind when a person like Dr GMS Choudhary departs for his heavenly abode leaving behind a huge void among his family members, friends and admirers. He was born and brought up in Dibrugarh and did his schooling. did his Pre-University and He from Cotton College ioined Medical College from graduated Assam where he in 1972 He joined AMC Dibrugarh as Registrar of Surgery in 1975 subsequent to which he obtained his MS degree in general surgery. After then he served at Guwahati Medical College for ten years. He returned to Assam Medical College in 1988 and and retired in 2007 as Professor of Surgery. Dr Choudhary was a brilliant surgeon and academician who was awarded FICS in 1985. He was a lifetime member of numerous academic bodies and he delivered lectures in various national and state level conferences. He was one of the pioneer of laparoscopic surgery in the North-Eastern India Apart from academics, he was very well known in literary circles and was associated with various literary and social organizations of Dibrugarh. He was also an avid poet writing poems highlighting burning topics of the society. I have lost a good and dear friend, who was batch mate of mine at his sad demise. I found him to be a very honest, pious, benevolent human being who was always concerned with other's difficulties and problems. I miss him very much and pray to God to render his soul eternal peace.


## Online EC Meeting Held
